* SMART PHONE CAMERAS ARE GOOD FOR THIS PURPOSE.




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TIPS FOR Planning your shoot:

MAKE SURE THE CAR IS CLEAN.

- Wash the car before taking photos.
- Remove any personal items from the interior.
- If there are seat and steering wheel covers please remove these so that the condition of the interior is visible.



SHOOT AT THE RIGHT TIME OF DAY.

- Avoid shooting in direct sunlight or at night.
- The best time of day to take photos is known as the Golden hour: first hour after sunrise or the last hour before sunset.
- Alternatively shoot in a shaded area.







BACKGROUND & LOCATION.

- Unless if your photos are being shot by a pro with correct equipment, photos taken outside will produce better results.
- A clean simple background is best.
- Avoid having items in the background that will distract the eye (telephone poles, dirt bins, people etc.).
- Use a location that suits the vehicle:
 - A sportscar will look out of place in an off-road setting
 - A 4x4 will be out of place at a racetrack
















DO NOT SHOOT INTO THE SUN.


- Always make sure the sun is behind you.
- Make sure your shadow is not visible in the image.



BE AWARE OF REFLECTIONS.

- Be careful that your own reflection is not visible in the photo or trees or buildings etc.
- Try and focus the natural horizon reflection on the side of the car and sky's reflection on side windows.







KEEP YOUR DISTANCE.

- Do not stand too close to the car when taking photos.
- Keep a good amount of space between the car and borders of the image.






DON'T FORGET THE FULL DISCLOSURE. DETAILS.

- Be upfront regarding any flaws or defects on the car. Take photos of these areas.
- Do not hide or photoshop out any flaws.
